With a National and two other Club events running in Scotland on the same day a low turn-out was expected at David Yeaman's Glenlomond farm. However, on the day it was pleasing to see 30 riders attend for the four lap, ten section course which was run in unexpected bright sunshine but with a biting cold wind. The sections were variations of turns and root steps on grass bankings in the woodland and in these drying conditions they turned out to be easier than had it been wet. Unexpected visitor, former Scottish Championship contender Nick Smith, pushed Willie Gillespie all the way and at the end there was little in it. Non Expert A winner Scott Alexander, on an SSDT shakedown ride, was also a welcome visitor alongwith riding buddy John Garrioch. Stephen Baird was pleased with his ride beating Allan Adamson by a mark, something he's never done before! Allan had, for him, a poor first 2 laps of 26, redeeming himself with only 2 marks lost on laps 3 & 4. Lee Collins had a fine ride especially since he opted to ride some of the easier A route lines for practise. As usual, the Over 40 class was the most subscribed with a third of the entry and it was close at the top with Dougie Bald, also on an SSDT shakedown ride on his Pre-65, just pipped by Russell Whiteford. Russell might have bettered his score had his minder, burly lorry driver, Jim Tennant not been elsewhere! Jim Buchan out for only the second time on his new Beta took third. Thomas Wibberley, out for the first time on a new Sherco, took the B Class uncontested. Brother, Henry, and new rider and C Class winner Connor Smith rode a modified route of 2 laps and both enjoyed their day. Another new man was Colin Wilson (Beta TR34) who was being ably guided round by Raymond Cockerill until the wheel bearings collapsed on the Beta after 2 laps. Next Club round at Knockhill on 25th May.
