As usual the biggest class was the over 40s. Steve Corry had a great win here with Mike Carruthers, another one back after a 2year sabbatical 'doing nothing', just five marks astern. As usual Bob (I'm under 40) Malloch competed on the harder route but still nudged Dougie Bald on his Cub off the podium. Dougie was hoping to debut his 250F Scorpa at this trial, but the delivery didn't turn out quite as planned!

An excellent entry of A class youth riders saw Mike McNiven lift first place again, his frequent trips to the north of England trials are paying off.
